

INTRODUCTION

The Ebbsfleet Design Forum was set up in 2022 by Frame Projects on behalf of the Ebbsfleet Development Corporation. It is chaired by Prof. Sadie Morgan and includes 24 professional members, selected through an open recruitment process in collaboration with Ebbsfleet Development Corporation officers.

Terms of reference, available on the planning authority's website, set out the role and remit of the panel, and the way in which it supports the planning process. Schemes requiring design advice are identified by planning officers and referred to the panel for review. Officers provide a briefing on the planning context and key issues, both in writing for the meeting agenda, and in person at the panel meeting. Advice given by the panel is recorded in a report, to assist with continuing pre-application negotiations, or to advise the planning committee on submitted schemes.

Ebbsfleet Design Forum has advised on 5 schemes in the year from May 2023 to April 2024. Reviews usually take place at a stage when a client and design team have decided their preferred option for the development of a site, and have sufficient drawings, models, etc. for a comprehensive discussion. There will often be a second pre-application review, to provide advice on more detailed design matters, before planning submission.
